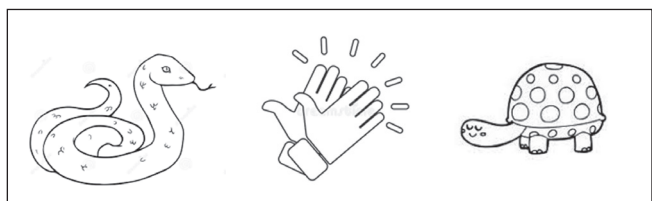


Resource Sheet: Example of a 'Secret Symbol' card

The card illustrated here was designed to help the child to remember their /s/ sound, to clap the syllables of tricky words, and to speak slowly. The child chose the pictures that they felt best represented what they needed to remember.



Involving the child in discussions about what will help them to remember their good sounds will not only be more meaningful for them but will also help them take some responsibility for their speech practice.

Other examples include:

A visual reminder for the child to help them remember to use the /s/ sound at the end of 'yes'.



A visual reminder for the child to help them remember the position of their tongue when using their /t/ and /d/ sounds.
